Instruction Sheet Front Adjustable Swaybar Link

N.B: This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual

- 1. Vehicle is to be raised evenly and safely supported.
- 2. Un-bolt and remove the OE swaybar links.
- 3. Prior to fitment of the new heavy duty adjustable units, confirm the ball ends are threaded in evenly at both ends of the center turn buckle.
- 4. Note the 2 steel spacers supplied place the spacers over the lower ball stud (swaybar mounting point) prior to fitment.
- 5. Note the 4 washers supplied these are to be place on the upper mounting point, both sides of the mounting bracket on the strut (2 per side of vehicle).
- 6. Mount the LH swaybar link forward of the strut as per image 1.
- 7. Mount the RH swaybar link rear of the strut as per image 2.
- 8. Tighten the 4 ball studs.
- 9. You now have the ability to fine-tune/remove any unwanted swaybar pre load by simply turning the long centre nut this is to be done preferably at ride height.
- 10.Tighten the 4 lock nuts.
- 11 Re check after inital 100kms travelled.

• Note the supplied spacers located at the lower swaybar mounting point.
